### Facility Background and Upcoming Work

For almost 100 years, Kerr-McGee and its predecessors treated railroad ties at the Facility, leading to creosote-related contamination in the soil and groundwater at and around the Facility. The Multistate Trust has been prioritizing evaluating the off-Facility migration of contaminants that may potentially affect the surrounding community.

In 2023, the Multistate Trust plans to:

- Collect additional surface soil samples from residential yards
- Evaluate residential sewer laterals and replace damaged laterals
- Collect groundwater samples from City public supply wells
- Collect information to develop a revised management plan for the Golden Hills Detention Basin
